RESOLUTION NO. 17-202

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR TO ISSUE A MORATORIUM RELATIVE TO THE GRANTING OF FRANCHISE OF MOTORIZED TRICYCLE FOR HIRE TO APPLICANTS IN ZONE I PURPOSELY FOR THE THOROUGH STUDY OF THE CITY'S TRAFFIC CONGESTION PROBLEM

WHEREAS, as of July 31, 2017, the number of motorized tricycle for hire totaled to 1,121 units in Zone 1 resulting to traffic congestion and pollution at the city streets;

WHEREAS, it is the consensus of this Body through the SP Committee on Public Utilities to limit the granting of franchise for the above-mentioned zone up to 1,400 units only;

WHEREAS, in the event that the **franchisee** intends not to renew or opted to have his/her franchise cancelled during the renewal period, the new applicant/s over and above the 1,400 could fill-in the vacancy on a “**first come, first serve basis**”, hence, the waiting **list** for this purpose should be maintained with corresponding contact numbers of applicants for ready reference;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. CARMONA, duly seconded by Hons. GUSTILO, MANSUETO and VILLARANTE, it was,

RESOLVED, to authorize the City Mayor to issue a moratorium relative to the granting of franchise of motorized tricycle for hire of motorized tricycle for hire to applicants in Zone I paving the way for the thorough study of the city's traffic congestion problem.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to direct the City Treasurer's Office (Business Permits and Licensing Office) to coordinate with the Office of the Sangguniang Panlungsod for the effective implementation of this moratorium.

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this resolution to the City Mayor, City Legal Office and City Treasurer (BPLO) for their information and appropriate action.
