



Located at Barangay Palampas, San Carlos City, Negros Occidental



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The City of San Carlos and its new Central Business District known as the "Center Mall" features wide landscaped thoroughfares and open spaces. Adjacent areas to the city's business district is the location of the City Hall and its open space.

The proposed project features landscape design by planting various ornamental trees and plants. The plants and ground covers add colors and enhances the overall look of the open space. Trees provides shade and soil stabilization. In addition, landscape fence will also be place and surround the perimeter of the two existing fountains. It will also serve as barriers in securing the area of plants. As a whole, the landscape design promotes social interaction and enhances community appeal.

II. GENERAL OBJECTIVE

The Design Concept aims to:

- (1) Improve landscape area by planting various ornamental trees and plants.
- (2) Improve landscape area by placing a perimeter fence surrounding each fountain area.

III. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

The work to be undertaken by the Contractor under this Contract shall include;

- o Furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment, plant, tools, and other incidentals necessary to complete in all respect the various items of work involved in the development/ landscaping of the two interactive musical fountain area such as:
 - a. Mobilization/ Demobilization
 - b. Site clearing and lay outing
 - c. Softscape works (various ornamental trees and plants)



- d. Perimeter/landscape fence
- e. Support facility
- This work includes furnishing, installing, landscaping, maintaining, and removal of Temporary Construction Facilities. The contractor shall set sanitation and safety a high priority during the construction. After completion of work the Contractor shall remove all temporary facilities and shall restore the area to its original state.
 - The contractor shall start the Mobilization five (5) days after the issuance of Notice to Proceed. Demobilization of idle materials, waste, equipment, tools, and other means that are not included on the finished project shall take place before the pre-turnover inspection.
- o All workmanship and materials shall be subjected to inspection by the project in charged, who may select samples of materials in such number and quantities as he/she may deem necessary to determine their conformance with the specifications and project intent.
- Disinfected, cleared, and free from any hazardous and perilous materials shall be considered completed project, and ready for pre-turnover of the project.
- o The contractor shall have necessary construction tools, landscaping tools and equipment needed to complete the project such as but not limited to rakes, shovel, trimmer, wheelbarrow, and safety equipment.
- Recommendations shall be complied with the specific given time agreed by the Architect and the Contractor. Then, it shall be ready for final turnover of the project.
