



The Park features a variety of landscape aesthetics especially paved path walks and greeneries. Likewise, adjacent to the park is the esplanade and the multi-purpose building. Its primary purpose is to cater visitors' planned activities and events among residents and local tourists plying in and out of the city. The adjacent open space area in between the multi-purpose building and esplanade is ideal for another proposed landscape improvement. But due to its current poor soil condition, the said peripheral areas need to be improved to be able to make a good landscaping activity vis-à-vis adding up adequate good top soil suitable for the planting of ornamental plants and other vegetation for landscaping. These as well supports plant growth, and provides good water retention, drainage and aeration.

II. GENERAL OBJECTIVE

The proposed project aims to provide a foundation for the preparation of softscape (planting of ornamental plants & greeneries) as future development, resulting to create a spectacular view overlooking the esplanade and seascape fronting the Island of Sipaway. Likewise, its future softscape development will serves as another tourist attraction to residents, visitor's and local tourists for the City of San Carlos.

III. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

The work to be undertaken by the Contractor under this Contract shall include;

- Furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment, plant, tools, and other incidentals necessary to complete in all respect the various items of work involved such as:
 - Mobilization and demobilization
 - Support construction facility



- Site Clearing/ Layouting and hauling of excavated/scraped materials
- Landscape works (replacement of garden soil/top soil from the excavated/scraped materials)
- Work includes clearing and hauling of existing ground soil; perimeter layouting, filling and grading of garden soil with an area of 1333 square meters with an average depth of 0.30 meters; maintaining, and removal of Temporary Construction Facilities. The contractor shall set sanitation and safety a high priority during the construction. After completion of Work the Contractor shall remove all temporary facilities and shall restore the temporary facilities area to its original state.
- The contractor shall start the Mobilization five (5) days after the
 issuance of Notice to Proceed. Demobilization of idle materials,
 waste, equipment, tools, and other means that are not included on
 the finished project shall take place before the pre-turnover
 inspection.
- All workmanship and materials shall be subjected to inspection by the Project in charged, who may select samples of materials in such number and quantities as may deem necessary to determine the conformance with the specifications and project intent.
- Disinfected, cleared, and free from any hazardous and perilous materials shall be considered completed project, and ready for pre-turnover of the project.
- The contractor shall have the necessary heavy equipments that are needed to complete the project such as but not limited to excavator, dump truck, grader and compactor.
- Recommendations shall be complied with the specific given time agreed by the Architect and the Contractor. Then, it shall be ready for final turnover of the project.
